Due to the financial limitations, there are a lot of capable students who are seriously thinking of dropping professional education altogether. These students will miss the chance of professional education thus impacting their full job potential and contribution to the economy in the long run. Looking at this situation, the parental trust JNIESTR decided to help these capable students with scholarship. The JNIESTRT Scholarship is awarded to the students who appear for JNIESTRT Scholarship Exam on merit basis, students studying in other institutions run by JNIESTRT as well as students who are immediate relative of employees of JNIESTRT.

Provider / Benefactor: Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Education, Science & Technological Research Trust (JNIESTRT).

Scholarship amount: Rs. 10,000/- to Rs. 30,000/- per year (above Rs.30,000/- is purely on the discretion of the JNIESTRT and recommendation of Director) (* subject to fulfillment of criteria laid down by JNIESTRT)

Eligibility criteria:

- 1) Candidate must be a graduate passed with minimum 50% marks in graduation.
- Candidate should appear for any recognized entrance exam for MMS and score nonzero marks in entrance.
- 3) Candidates willing to take admission in RGCMS for MMS program.
- 4) Candidates should score minimum 50% in Scholarship Exam and 50% in Personal Interview / Candidates should belong to other institutions run by JNIESTRT / Candidates should be immediate relative of employees of JNIESTRT.

How to apply:

- 1) Complete online scholarship application form on the RGCMS website.
- 2) Upload relevant document.

Shortlisting process:

- 1) Candidates will be called for JNIESTRT Scholarship Exam after scrutiny of their application.
- 2) Candidates will have to appear for JNIESTRT Scholarship Exam.

 Candidates scoring minimum 50% in JNIESTRT Scholarship Exam will have to appear for Personal Interview with representatives of JNIESTRT.

Terms and conditions:

- JNISETR's decision of offering / rejecting the scholarship and the total amount of scholarship will be final.
- This scholarship will be in addition to any other scholarship / freeship received from Government of India / Maharashtra by the candidate.
- Scholarship will be offered to the candidates on the basis of composite score in JNIESTRT Scholarship Exam and Personal Interview.
- Candidate should possess continuous good academic record throughout MMS program.
- Reimbursement of scholarship amount is subject to endorsement / recommendation by Head of the Institute based on the candidate's academic performance (participation in activities, attendance, exam etc.).
